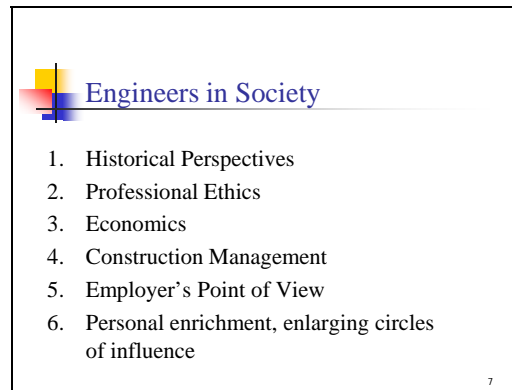


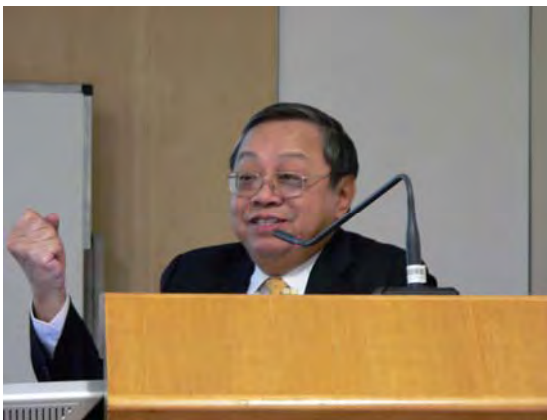
BSE Public CPD Lecture – Engineers in Society on 7 March 2011
